- 4. What kind of attitude did the servant have that was sent by Abraham to find a bride for Isaac? Would you call him an "unsung" hero in the Bible? If so why?
- 5. What are you noticing about the faith of Abraham as his life moves along?
- 6. Has God only revealed himself to the immediate family of Abraham (24:50-51)?
- 7. Who are the children born to Isaac and Rebekah and what type of individuals are they?
- 8. How did Jacob trick Essau? Does Jacob seem to be an individual of strong faith? Because of Jacob's trick, what consequences come his way?
- 9. What type of a person is Laban? How did he trick Jacob?
- 10. We see polygamy in the Old Testament. do you think this is God's will? Why or why not?
- 11. Why did Jacob leave Laban (31:3)?
- 12. What stopped Laban from taking out his wrath on Jacob after he left?
- 13. Who did Jacob wrestle with and what symbolism do we see in this (32:22-30)?
- 14. How did Essau react to his reunion with Jacob who had stolen his birthright?
- 15. When Dinah was defiled, how did her brothers react? What does this tell us about them?
