8. What is still clear to Job in 19:25-27?

4. What can be learned from the mistakes of Simon in chapter 8? What do we learn about the Holy Spirit in this section?
5. What do we learn from the conversion of the Ethiopian eunuch? How was he converted? What did he desire right after his conversion?
6. How was Saul converted in chapter 9? What problems would he at first face from the Christians considering his previous history?
7. Who helps Paul in his transition into the family of believers (9:27)?
8. Who is Tabitha and what happens to her? What do we learn from this?
9. How was the church doing during this time (9:31)?
