7. Read 7:10-14. How is this prophecy fulfilled? How much time goes by between the time the prophecy is given and it is fulfilled?
8. Who does Isaiah wed in 8:3-4 and what is the meaning of the name they gave their son?
9. Read carefully 9:2-7. Who does this section of the Scripture refer to and what names are given Him in verse 6?
10. Despite Israel's rebellion, what hope is given in 10:20-22?
11. Read carefully 11:1-11. Who does this section refer to? Who is the shoot of Jesse? Revelation makes reference to the sevenfold Spirit. What seven attributes are given the Holy Spirit in 11:2?
12. In 12:2, where does salvation come from?
13. How is 14:1-2 fulfilled?
14. What prophecy is given in 19:22-25? What meaning can be pulled from this?

11. How is someone to be treated who has been caught in sin (6:1-5)?
12. What does 6:10 say about the attitude we should have for others?
13. What should we boast about in life (6:14)?
14. What is God’s purpose and plan for our lives (Ephesians 1:4-5)?
15. How are we marked and what has God given us to assure our salvation?
