4. Who alone could go into the Holy Place and the Holy of Holies? Who were the priest a symbol of?
5. Why were the people of Israel not allowed to eat blood? What was blood a symbol of? Who has fulfilled the regulation for us and how has He done this?
6. Read 18:27-29. What does this say about the practices of the people who lived in the promised land prior to the Israelites and what does it say will happen to the people of Israel if they do the same things?
7. Read Leviticus 19:31. Was the new age movement a reality then as well?
8. Read Leviticus 19:33-34. How were the Israelites to treat foreigners?
9. What are some of the rules of the priest? Were they allowed to marry? Why would a priest have to be without a defect? Why were the sacrifices to be without blemish?
10. What is gleaning?
11. Refer to the list of feast and sacred days and learn the meaning of these holy days. Are any similar to our Christian holy days?
12. In Leviticus 26:40-42 what were the people to do before they were to sacrifice?
13. What is the tithe (Leviticus 27:30-32)?

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

6. What is significant about the curtain of the temple being torn in two (27:51)?
7. Read 27:62-66. Why was such care taken in making sure the tomb that Jesus was placed in, was secure?
8. How do we know the story told by the elders could not be true in 28:11-15?
9. What does the resurrection of Jesus mean to us today?
10. What does Matthew 28:18-20 mean for us in our lives today?
11. What main events happen in chapter 1 of Mark? Does Mark waste any time getting into the ministry of Jesus?

13. How do we explain the meaning of 2:21-22?
