Welcome to Kid's Ministry!

We're glad you're here! We want to partner with you and resource you to pass down the faith to your children. We hope that your kids experience the saving grace and love of Jesus every week at Children's Church, where they can learn, grow, and have fun.

Our Approach

Our mission is simply two things: Teaching Truth and Transforming Lives. We believe God's Word is true and relevant for our lives today. Each week at Children's Church, kids read and experience true stories from the Bible. They also learn how to apply these principles throughout the week, and allow the Holy Spirit to transform their lives.

Looking at Deuteronomy 6 (on inside cover) we see that God is calling parents to be the primary teachers to pass down the faith. In our culture today, many parents feel alone and ill-equipped, so that's why at Hope we want partner with you. In Deuteronomy 6, God is not only addressing parents, but also the whole faith community to teach the next generation. This is why kids are given take-it-home flyers, so parents can have a conversation about the lesson on the way home or around the dinner table. This is also why we do family events, so that families can play together and strengthen their relationships.

Curriculum - Simply Loved

During Children' Church, we use a curriculum called "Simply Loved" by Group Publishing. We love this curriculum because it's Biblically-based, media-driven, and interactive. Kids will not only hear the Bible story, but will help act it out. This not only makes the lessons more engaging, but it helps the kids remember the story.





Children's Church at 9:30

Welcome to Children's Church, where kids and families worship together - to sing the opening worship songs and engage in a time of confession. After the confession, the children will be dismissed to follow their teacher to their classroom.

Why are we doing this? We believe in children worshipping together with their families and the congregation. Not only does this provide quality family time, but kids get to participate in corporate worship with the whole church. They get to see adults model the faith, and when it's time to enter 6th grade, they're used to this kind of worship. And according to studies (Sticky Faith) the #1 indicator of life-long discipleship is whether they develop a habit of being in worship. We dismiss after the confession so they can receive teaching at their development level.

Check-In Location

Check-in your kids at the Welcome Center in the courtyard. Infants through age 2 can be brought to the nursery but all other kids once checked in, will go to the sanctuary with their families. As always, the kids will be given a printed name tag and parents will receive one with a code that matches their child's name tag. Hang onto this for pickup.

Dismissal & Pickup

Dismissal

About 15 minutes into the worship service (after the confession) kids will be dismissed and will follow their teacher to their classroom.

Pickup

Once service ends, you will pickup your kids in their classrooms (make sure you show the printed label with the code on it that you received at check in).



Classes

Some grades have many kids in them, and others have only a few, so we're adjusting the classes.

Behavior

Children's Church is a safe place that is welcoming, friendly, and allows kids to experience the love of Jesus. We expect children to participate, have fun, and treat everyone with respect. When a child is disruptive, it creates a distracted and unsafe environment. We have three steps to enforce discipline, so that all children can be ministered to:

Step 1 - In-Class

When a child is disruptive or disrespectful, the teacher or shepherd will give them a warning. This is to let them know what they did was inappropriate, and to correct the behavior in the future. If the behavior persists more than once that day, the teacher will notify the parents.

Step 2 - Parent / Buddy

If the issue persists after a couple weeks, and in-class mediation does not help, we move to step two. A parent is asked to attend Children's Church with their child and be their "buddy". The buddy will be the first contact to stop the disruptive behavior, and remove the child from the class if necessary.

Step 3 - At-Home

One of the neat things about Simply Loved is that we have all the lessons available on a Google Drive. Rather than attending Children's Church in the classroom, parents and children can do everything at home - sing the songs, watch the Bible Buddy video, and re-enact the Bible story. After a period of time, parents and Mike Edge can reevaluate if the child is ready to come back.


