



## It's The End Of The World As We Know It

### Daily Devotionals

#### Day 1 — Trusting God With the Unknown

**Key Verse:** *"See that no one leads you astray... the end is not yet."* — Matthew 24:4,6

**Reflection:**

People have always wondered about the end of the world. Wars, disasters, and cultural turmoil make it feel close at hand. But Jesus reminds us that these signs have existed in every generation. The truth is simple: **we don't know when the end will come**. And that's exactly why Jesus directs our attention away from timetables and toward Himself.

We want certainty, but God gives us something better—a **trustworthy Savior**. Instead of predicting dates or fearing headlines, He calls us to rest in His promise that He is with us, no matter what comes. Like an earthquake that strikes without warning, the end will arrive suddenly. But for those in Christ, it will not be a moment of fear—it will be the moment our Redeemer appears in glory.

**Prayer:**

Lord Jesus, calm my anxious heart. When I am tempted to fear the future, turn my eyes back to You. Help me trust Your Word and Your timing, confident that my life is secure in Your hands. Amen.

## Day 2 — Standing Firm in Trials

**Key Verse:** *“The one who endures to the end will be saved.”* — Matthew 24:13

**Reflection:**

Some Christians teach that believers will be removed from suffering before the final days. But Jesus says something different. He tells us that His people will face hardship—and in the midst of it, He will sustain them. The goal of our lives is not to escape difficulty but to **remain faithful to Christ in it**.

When trials come, Jesus promises that our endurance will glorify Him before the world. Our courage, rooted not in ourselves but in Christ’s strength, becomes a testimony to the Gospel. Hardship is not a sign that God has abandoned us; it is a place where He proves Himself faithful again and again.

**Prayer:**

Lord, strengthen me to endure with faith. When suffering comes, keep me from fear and fill me with the confidence that You are with me. Let my life honor You in every trial. Amen.

## Day 3 — Christ Will Return in Glory

**Key Verse:** *“They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.”* — Matthew 24:30

**Reflection:**

Jesus’ return will not be secret or hidden. Scripture describes a cosmic, unmistakable event—the sun darkened, the heavens shaken, and Christ appearing in glory for all to see. Every knee will bow, and every eye will behold Him.

For believers, this is not a day of dread but a day of deliverance. Jesus will gather His people from every corner of the earth. Everything broken will be restored. Everything sinful will be removed forever. When the Lord comes, life as we know it will change—and for God’s children, it will change for the better.

No matter what disasters or trials you’ve lived through, nothing compares to the glory Christ will reveal when He appears.

**Prayer:**

Lord Jesus, fix my hope on Your return. Let the promise of Your coming fill me with joy, courage, and perseverance. Help me long for the day when You make all things new. Amen.

## Day 4 — Staying Awake and Unafraid

**Key Verse:** *“Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.”* — Matthew 24:42

**Reflection:**

The world tells us not to worry about spiritual things—just live normally, focus on the present, and trust human solutions. Jesus warns us that this kind of complacency is dangerous. In Noah’s day, people went on with life as usual until judgment came. They weren’t prepared.

Just as Noah and his family were “left behind” in the sense of being preserved by God, so believers will be kept safe through judgment, not removed from it. We do not fear that day because Christ has rescued us by His cross. Still, He calls us to remain alert—anchored in His Word, strengthened by His promises, and guarded against false teachings that distract us from Him.

**Prayer:**

Lord, keep me awake in faith. Guard my heart from deception, complacency, and fear. Help me cling to Your Word with clarity and confidence. Amen.

## Day 5 — Living Ready Today

**Key Verse:** *“You also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.”* — Matthew 24:44

**Reflection:**

Jesus doesn’t tell us when the end will come—but He does tell us how to live while we wait. Not in fear. Not in procrastination. Not assuming there’s plenty of time to think about eternal things later. He calls us to live ready **today**.

Readiness isn’t about stocking supplies or decoding prophecies. It’s about faith—daily trusting Jesus, confessing sin, receiving forgiveness, and walking in His grace. We may not know when the last day will arrive, but we know this: **Christ’s promises are sure, and our hope is secure in Him.**

Whether our last day comes at the end of time or at the end of our earthly life, Jesus wants us anchored in His love, strengthened by His Word, and confident in the salvation He won for us.

**Prayer:**

Lord Jesus, prepare my heart for Your coming. Teach me to live each day in repentance, faith, and joyful hope. Hold me close until the day I see You face to face. Amen.
